Dr John Cole is a leading strategic thinker and advisor in sustainable development. An early proponent of triple-bottom-line thinking in government and industry, since the mid 1980s he has been involved in public policy, industry development, environment management and community empowerment - variously as a parliamentary adviser/speech writer, company manager, industry lobbyist, chief executive of an NGO, public servant and occasional university teacher.

John is the Executive Director of the Environmental Protection Agency's Sustainability Innovation Division. He is also an Adjunct Professor in industry, organisational and community sustainability at three leading Queensland universities.
